HUMAN TRAFFICKING 101

This session focuses on learning what human trafficking is and how to spot it. Attendees will learn the definitions of trafficking, tactics of a trafficker, who is most vulnerable, and ways to best support survivors and anti-trafficking efforts. After the formal presentation, time will be allotted for a question-and-answer segment as well as a robust discussion on scenarios.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING 201

This session focuses on learning what human trafficking is and how to spot it. This session will dive deeper into what makes an individual vulnerable, factors that may increase risk, protective factors for individuals and communities, prevention efforts, reporting protocols for professionals, and service interventions. After the formal presentation, time will be allotted for a question-and-answer segment as well as a robust discussion on scenarios.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

This session focuses on increasing professionals understanding of best practices for service providers. Attendees will learn the 15 guiding principles, dive deep into discussion of the importance of best practices, and complete an assessment of their organization's practices.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND HEALTHCARE

This session will examine indicators to understand the intersection between public health and trafficking, increase knowledge of identifying and accessing services specific to human trafficking, and go over case scenarios that may occur in a healthcare setting. After the formal presentation, time will be allotted for a question-and-answer segment as well as a robust discussion on scenarios.

SCREENING AND IDENTIFICATION

This session will expand the attendee's knowledge of screening tools and techniques and expand understanding of integrating screening into the intake process to increase identification of trafficking. After the formal presentation, time will be allotted for a question-and-answer segment as well as a robust discussion on scenarios.

PREVENTION AND RESPONSE

This session will focus on prevention efforts educators can put in place to decrease the risk of trafficking for students. Attendees will learn various response protocols that can be put in place.

IMPACTED POPULATIONS: WHAT MAKES THEM VULNERABLE AND WAYS TO INCREASE PROTECTIVE FACTORS

This session focuses on the populations most at risk of being trafficked and explores risk factors, protective factors, tactics utilized by the trafficker, and appropriate interventions for each. After the formal presentation, time will be allotted for a question-and-answer segment as well as a robust discussion on scenarios.

TAILORED TRAINING

This session is tailored to focus on the needs of the individual agency. BEI will meet with the client to identify the areas of focus and craft the training to fit the scope.

TRAIN THE TRAINERS

This session focuses on training other professionals to train their staff on Human Trafficking 101 and/or 201.
